

Diogo Zuzarte Martins, owner and founder of AdegaMor based in Sobral de Monte Agraco, has expanded the family wine business over the last 15 years. It all began in 1946 when his Grandfather Francisco Zuzate Martins started cultivating vines in the Lisbon region. This company run three vineyards; Quinta de Sao José da Lage, Quinta di Boticaria and more recently Quinta da Nossa Senhora Encarnação. Today the family own about 200 Hectares of vines, and also rent further smaller vineyards.

Calçada Velha Wine result from a blend of new grape varieties from Quinta a Boticaria and old portuguese grape varieties from Quinta de São José da Lage.

REGION: Lisboa

VINEYARDS: Wine produced from a belnd grapes varieties. A part from old vines planed at São Jose da Lage properties with the new vines produced at Boticaria Farm.

WINEMARKER: Pedro Gil and Carina Tavares

GRAPE VARIETIES: Touriga Nacional, Castelão, Tinta Roriz and Alicante Bouschet and a part of old vineyards.

TASTING NOTES: An intensely coloured wine with red fruit on the nose. Deliciously spicy, with notes of toasted coffee/ chocolate/moka. Well balanced with good tannic structure and a long finish.

VINIFICATION: Fermentation at controlled temperature of

28ºC.

AGED: Wood Aging in french oak during 6 months.

ANALYSIS: Alcohol Content: 13,5% vol.

Total Acidity: 5 gr/lt

Residual Sugar: 5 gr/lt

SERVICE AND CONSERVATION: Should be served at a temperature between 16/18°C. Stay the bottles layed down when it's possible and in a room with controlled temperature, 12°C if you can.

GASTRONOMIC SUGGESTION: Pair with red meat or mediterranean dishes.
