



Diogo Zuzarte Martins, owner and founder of AdegaMor based in Sobral de Monte Agraço, has expanded the family wine business over the last 15 years. It all began in 1946 when his Grandfather Francisco Zuzarte Martins started cultivating vines in the Lisbon region. This company runs three vineyards; Quinta de São José da Lage, Quinta di Boticaria and more recently Quinta da Nossa Senhora Encarnação. Today the family owns about 200 Hectares of vines, and also rents further smaller vineyards.

REGION: Lisboa

VINEYARDS: São José da Lage located at Alenquer sub-region.

WINEMARKER: Pedro Gil and Carina Tavares

GRAPE VARIETIES: Wine produced mainly from Syrah and Castelão vineyards with more 20% of old vineyards planted at São José da Lage.

TASTING NOTES : Fruity with notes of red wild berries and spices. Good structure, smooth tannins and persistent aftertaste.

VINIFICATION: Fermentation at controlled temperature of 28°C.

AGED: Ageing in French and American oak during 6 months.

ANALYSIS: Alcohol Content: 14,5% vol.

Total Acidity: 4 gr/l

Residual Sugar: 4 gr/l

SERVICE AND CONSERVATION: Should be served at a temperature between 16/18°C. Store the bottles laid down when it's possible and in a room with controlled temperature, 12°C if you can.

GASTRONOMIC SUGGESTION: Accompany well with red meat or Mediterranean dishes.
